This application must be personally delivered to the East Greenbush Community Library addressed to the Director no later than the 7th day before the election (September 10th by 5pm). The election will be held on Tuesday, September 17, 2024, from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. The ballot itself must be postmarked by a governmental postal service no later than the day before the election (September 16th) and received at the library no later than the 7th day after the election (September 24th).

East Greenbush Community Library Budget Vote & Trustee Election

Tuesday, September 17, 2024, from 9 AM-8 PM in the library.

Voter Eligibility

- You must be an East Greenbush resident to vote in this election.
- Residency verification is required for issuance of voting ballot.

Deadlines:

Please follow the instructions carefully. Allow enough time to receive and mail back your application and completed ballot by the associated deadlines. Full instructions for submitting your ballot will be provided with the ballot mailing.

- Begins 8/21: Tentatively, if final ballot information is ready, we will begin mailing out absentee ballots to applicants the week of 8/26/24. Ballots cannot be produced and mailed until we have the final budget and Trustee candidate information. Instructions for completing your ballot will be provided in the mailer.
- 9/10
(5PM) Last day you can request and submit absentee ballot application in person.
Residency will be validated before a blank ballot is issued.
- 9/10-9/16 You may submit, in person, your completed ballot one day before (9/16/24) the election (election day is 9/17/24) AND in order for your vote to be counted you must also do the following:
- Address the envelope to the Director.
 - Seal the envelope.
 - On the back seal, include date, your signature and printed name.
 - Staff must date and initial your sealed ballot upon receipt, and it must be received before 9/17/24.
- 9/16 If sending your completed ballot by mail, it must be postmarked by 9/16/24 (1 day before the election which is September 17, 2024).
- 9/24 7th day after the election is the last day your mailed ballot (USPS postmarked by 9/16/24 or sooner) can be received and counted.
